


SEA April Away Trip Fri-Sun, April 14-16, 2023

Xian & Terra Cotta Warriors Tour 3 Days

Discover the Terracotta Warriors, one of the eight wonders in the world

Destinations: Xian, ShaanXi Province Transportation: flight + coach + flight



Overview

Xi'an is located in central-northwest China, records the great changes of the country just like a living history book. Xi'an was served as one of seven ancient capitals in China, called Chang'an (meaning the eternal city) in ancient times, it is one of the birthplaces of the ancient Chinese civilization in the Yellow River Basin area. As the eastern terminal of the Silk Road and the site of the famous Terracotta Warriors of the Qin Dynasty, the city has won a reputation all over the world. More than 3,000 years of history including over 1,100 years as the capital city of ancient dynasties, have endowed the city with an amazing historical heritage. Xian is also the home of the Terracotta Warriors of the first emperor Qin Shi Huang, which is one of eight wonders in the world.

13:45-15:15 Beilin Museum visit

Xi'an Beilin Museum is a museum for steles and stone sculptures which is located in Xi'an, China. In 1944 it was the principal museum for Shaanxi Province on the site of what was formerly a 11th century Confucius Temple. Then because of the large number of steles, it was officially re-named as the Forest of Stone Steles in 1992. Altogether, there are 3,000 steals in the museum, which is divided into seven exhibitions halls, which mainly display works of calligraphy, painting, and historical records.

15:15 Drive to Ancient City Wall, approx. 3 km 15 min

15:30-17:00 Visit the Ancient City Wall, the ancient City Wall of Xian is the most intact ancient Chinese wall in existence. It is also the landmark of Xian. City Wall encircles and protects the ancient part of Xian City. Xian was the capital of thirteen different Chinese dynasties, so the need for a defensive structure such as the city wall was imperative. The current six-hundred-year-old City Wall is the most integrated ancient City Wall in China. It is one of the UNESCO's worlds Heritage Site

17:00 Drive to Night market street, approx. 4 km 20 min

This only 500-meter-long cobbled street was renovated in Tang Dynasty architecture style and on both sides is full of snack or souvenir stalls with bright-colored signs. The eye-dizzying snack variety can give a great workout to your eyes, taste buds and stomach: delicately-wrinkled juicy steamed dumplings, yummy lamb sandwiches, sleek grilled mutton, crumbs in mutton broth, stuffed persimmon cakes, dried fruit and nuts, etc.

Tang Dynasty Show at The Shaanxi Opera House

The Tang Dynasty was China's most colorful and prosperous dynasty. It is famous for its art, poetry, clothing, and cuisine. Visitors to Xi'an will have a chance to step back in time and relive this fantastic era at the Tang Dynasty Show. It is a spectacle of color, culture, music, and dance. The spectacular music and beautiful costumes with long flowing sleeves perfectly match and complement each other.

Day 2 April 15 Saturday Shaanxi History Museum, Terra Cotta Warriors Museum excursion (Breakfast and Lunch)





Hotel breakfast

09:00 Hotel departure, drive to Shaanxi History Museum, approx. 30 min 7 km

09:30-11:00 Visit Shaanxi History Museum, which is one of the first huge state museums with modern facilities in China. The museum houses over 300,000 items including murals, paintings, pottery, coins, as well as bronze, gold, and silver objects. The modern museum was built



between 1983 and 2001 and its appearance recalls the architectural style of the Tang Dynasty.

11:00 Drive to Terra Cotta Warriors Museum approx. 50 km 1 hour

12:00 Lunch on the way or near the Terra Cotta Warriors Museum

13:30 Today's highlight is to visit the Terra-cotta Warriors' Museum.

The high point of a trip to Xian comes when you stand at the edge of Emperor Qin Shihuang's vast funeral and gaze at the life like faces of his terra-cotta army. It was discovered in 1974 beneath a grassy mound about 20 miles (32 km) outside Xian. This tomb, remarkably, is not the emperor's actual resting place but a satellite tomb. The expense of excavating Qin's vault-said to be part of a vast under ground city crisscrossed by canals of mercury-has delayed the project indefinitely. You can tour the Terra-cotta Warrior reproduction factory.

At present, there are already 149 burial pits, 196 burial tombs have been discovered, including the Bronze Chariots pit, the Rare Birds pits, the Barns pits in small and large scales, the Stone Armor pit, the Warriors and Horses pits and other sacrificial pits. All those together build a massive treasure house. On March 4th 1961, the State Council declared Emperor Qinshihuang's mausoleum a major historical and culture sites protected at the national level, one of the first sited in the country. The mausoleum including the pits of Terra-cotta Warriors and Horses was listed as one of the UNESCO World Cultural Heritage Site.

After visit, transfer to your hotel in Xian

Day 3 April 16 Sunday Xian half day tour: Great Mosque and its bazaar and Big Wild Goose Pagoda Fly back to Shanghai (Breakfast and Lunch)





Hotel breakfast and check out

09:15 Departure, drive to Great Mosque and its bazaar, approx. 3-4 km 15 min

09:30-11:30 Visit the Great Mosque and its bazaar. The mosque was built in a Chinese architectural style with most of the grounds taken up by gardens still an active place of worship, the



mosque holds several prayer services each day. The bazaar at the entrance of Mosque is quite interesting for the visitors.

The Muslim Quarter is the largest of the old city's neighbourhoods. It's a confusing array of narrow alleys that are wonderful to wander in, get lost, and stumble upon surprising discoveries. Muslim Quarter houses a large number of important Christian institutions. The Muslim quarter begins at the northern city wall, goes south to the northern and western walls of the Temple Mount, to Hashalshelet Street, where the Jewish Quarter begins. To the West, it runs to Beit Chabad Street, which runs between it and the Christian Quarter.

11:30 Departure, drive to Big Goose Pagoda, approx. 9 km 30 min

12:00-13:00 Big Wild Goose Pagoda visit

Big Wild Goose Pagoda has been regarded as a symbol of the Xi'an city. It was built in AD 652, the pagoda has a 16. 4-foot-high (5 m) square base and reaches 212 feet (64.5 m) in height. It was built to house and protect Buddhist scriptures collected by Xuan Zang, a Buddhist monk who spent an epic 17 years traveling to India and back gathering them and an equal amount of time translating them.

13:00 Local Shaanxi delicious lunch near the site

14:00-15:00 Drive to Xian Xianyang airport for departure, approx. 50 km, 60 min

17:00 MU2165 Xian Xianyang airport departure

19:15 Shanghai Hongqiao airport Terminal 2 arrival, trip ends
